PENNY Challenge!!!

When: Monday, December 5 – Friday, December 9 during lunch!

Why: During the holiday season, we often forget what is really important. Instead of thinking what WE WANT for the holidays, we are going to raise money to donate to those who may not have as much as we do.

“One penny may not seem like a lot, but when hundreds of pennies come together, great things can happen!”

The Rules:

1. Each classroom will have a container with the teacher’s name displayed on the front. These containers will be in the lunchroom during the lunch hours and will be available after you finish eating. Mrs. Dennis and Mr. Strong will let you know when you can leave your tables.
2. You may bring in as many pennies as you want to put into your OWN classroom’s jug. The goal is to raise as much money as possible using only pennies. You will be amazed at the places you’ll find a penny (underneath couch cushions, pants’ pockets, closets, junk drawers, winter coats, the floor of a car, the ground, etc.)!!!! Before taking any money from home, please make sure it is okay with your parent/guardian first!!
3. Here’s the catch: Students may put in any silver coins into ANOTHER class’ jar. Silver coins deduct the face value of the coin from that class’ total. For example: Mrs. Meents’ class has about 200 pennies. Mrs. Dillon puts a quarter into Mrs. Meents’ jug. Now Mrs. Meents’ jug is only worth 175 pennies.
4. THE GOAL: At the end of the “Penny Challenge”, all pennies and silver coins will be counted. The winner of the “Penny Challenge” will be the class that raises the most money using pennies.
5. WHERE does the MONEY go? ALL money (pennies and silver coins) raised in our “Penny Challenge” will be donated to those in need at Kuzma Care Cottage this holiday season.
